Updates

The summer months were busy with annual leave and progressing projects, so this month's newsletter encompasses July, August, September, & October.

There were three successful bids in the ScotWind clearing round announced in August for the NE1 offshore wind site to the east of Shetland. The successful lead applicants were Mainstream RP, ESB, and Ocean Winds with 2.8GW of floating offshore wind to be developed and green hydrogen production being intimated as the preferred route to market. In late July, Shetland Island Council opened a request for Expression of Interest (EOI) for renewable industry development centred around the Port of Sullom Voe, Scatsta, & Sellaness areas. Submissions closed on the 30th of September. For more info, go here.

Shetland Islands Council are participating and investing in the Net Zero Technology Transition Programme led by Net Zero Technology Centre in Aberdeen. The programme is investigating the development of Energy Hubs in Scotland and a Hydrogen Backbone link from Scotland to Europe with Shetland considered a key hub and future hydrogen exporter.
