A range of projects were announced to commence around Shetland including the start of the long journey to floating offshore wind energy generation at the NE1 site allocated by the ScotWind Leasing Rounds in addition to those projects working towards decarbonisation of North Sea oil & gas assets.

Looking ahead to 2023

The ORION team is looking forward to a busy year ahead and will continue to facilitate the transition to cleaner energies and promoting Shetland as a key location for an energy hub.

The Net Zero Technology Transition Programme will be concluded in this quarter. The results of the Energy Hub and Hydrogen Backbone studies within this programme will inform the development of Shetland's future energy system.

The first components for the UK's most productive onshore windfarm have begun arriving this quarter. The Viking Energy Windfarm is still on schedule to be completed by the end of 2024.
